The Home Health Aide course examines the holistic approach to safely caring for patients in a variety of settings. While in this course, you will analyze how healthcare systems operate and how to function efficiently within a facility. You will also practice how to work on a healthcare team to meet patient needs. After completing this course and passing a state certification examination, you will play an essential role on a healthcare team by observing, reporting, and performing skills in a home health setting.

Objectives:

• Explore how to safely care for patients and residents in a variety of healthcare settings.

• Recognize the skills needed to pass the State of Utah Certified Nurse Assistant (C.N.A.) examination administered by UNAR.

• Identify the skills and knowledge necessary to be an essential part of the healthcare team and meet the needs of patients and residents.
